Reporting Results

- It is vital that this information is submitted on time, so as to ensure an orderly administration of the Leagues, the timely production of accurate league tables, and overall publication in the Farnham Herald. The Playcricket website is the only source used by the League in determining the averages when considering the players of the season.
- Should the deadline be missed, the Home Club will be automatically fined in accordance with Rule J of Section One.

I'Anson Women's Softball Rules 2022

- The length of the pitch is to be 19yds in all softball games.
- It is advised that each team bowl their innings from one end. This is to be decided before the game starts at the agreement of both captains.
- A team shall consist of a minimum of 8 player. Teams are to agree team size before the game if greater than 8.
- 8-a-side games shall be 16 overs in length for each innings.
- For each additional pair, an additional 4 overs shall be added to each innings (eg,. X8 = 16 overs, X10 = 20 overs)
- An over shall consist of 6 deliveries.
- No ball to be called at the discretion of the umpire, if a ball is bowled over chest height (In a batter's normal stance).
- Front foot no-balls should be given at the discretion of the umpire but only after multiple observations have been made to the bowler
- Wides to be given at the umpire's discretion if outside of the width of the tram lines with two runs awarded.
- Except for the final over, no extra ball shall be required to be delivered with respect to a "Wide Ball" or "No Ball".
- 2 runs will be added to the batting side for no balls & wides
- Each bowler can bowl a maximum of 4 overs.
- Games shall be played as "Pairs Cricket", with each pair batting for a total of 4 overs regardless of wickets lost.
- Both teams will start each game with a pre-set total of 200 runs.
- Runs scored shall be added to the batting side's total with the scoreboard updated at the end of every over.
- At the fall of each wicket, a total of 5 runs shall be deducted from the batting side's total.

- In the event that a club has more than one team in the league, each team is expected to select teams with consideration given to the spirit of cricket.
- All teams, umpires, players and coaches are encouraged to help to advise opposition players when appropriate
- All umpires are asked to consider a player's ability when applying any rule of the I'Anson League or any law of cricket. The I'Anson Ladies' Softball League is entry level and designed to encourage participation as well as competition. Advice should be afforded before the application of law when appropriate.

- The ladies' management committee have the right to investigate any aspect of l'Anson Ladies League matches, selection or result and take any action that it deems appropriate.
- The league positions will be decided by average points, calculated by dividing the points total by games completed.
- Match points to be awarded as follows – Win, 10 points; Tie, 5 points each; Loss, 0 Points. Bonus points to be added as set out.

Bonus Points:

- Bonus points are available to both the winning and losing sides.
- Bowling points: 1 bonus point to be given for every 3 wickets taken with a maximum of 3 bowling bonus points available.
- Batting points: 1 bonus point is to be given every 40 runs over 200 at the end of the game. Maximum of 3 bonus batting points available.

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I'ANSON CUP COMPETITIONS – CODE OF CONDUCT ON THE FIELD

1. The following Code of Conduct has been prepared in order to encourage improved standards of behaviour on the field or play and to reduce the degree of aggravation experienced by umpires, which has in recent years led to a reduction in the number of pool umpires available to stand. The Code is to be observed by all players who play in all I'Anson matches, whether cup or league.
2. Clubs shall be responsible for their players' conduct. They shall take all steps needed to ensure their members are familiar, and comply, with this Code
3. Team captains shall be responsible for the conduct of their players before during and after each match. In this regard, a captain must do whatever is needed, including sending offending team members from the field, either temporarily or for the duration of the match
4. The following represent unacceptable behaviour:
 - attempts to intimidate or distract opponents, by word or action.
 - aggressive behaviour
 - foul or abusive language
 - physical abuse of opponents
 - abuse of umpires, whether or not they are pool umpires
 - smoking or the drinking of alcohol on the field of play
 - wearing inappropriate clothing, which must be essentially white
5. Dissent at umpiring decisions is unacceptable. Players may politely ask an umpire to offer an explanation, to which the umpire is encouraged to respond. Requests for further explanation, even if expressed politely, are unacceptable.
6. Captains shall implement in full the decisions of the umpire during each match, without question. Where pool umpires are not available, it is the responsibility of captains to ensure that those asked to umpire are sufficiently competent to carry out their duties.
7. Where a captain is dissatisfied with the conduct of an umpire who is a member of the opposing side, the captain may after the match or during an interval politely address any complaint to the opposing captain and seek to resolve any dispute. Where it is not possible to resolve the dispute, the captain shall advise his opposite number that he will refer the matter to his Club Secretary, who may in turn send a full report to the Secretary of the I'Anson Management Committee within 72 hours of the match in question
8. Where a captain is dissatisfied with the conduct of a pool umpire and believes the matter is sufficiently serious to be brought to the attention of the Management Committee, the captain concerned should, after the match, send a report on the umpire's conduct to the Umpires' Secretary, after informing the umpire concerned and the opposing captain that he intends to do so.
9. Incidents, which appear to be in contravention of this Code, shall be reported within 72 hours of the match in question as follows:
 - Where pool umpires officiate, the umpires will report such incidents in the prescribed form or to the Management Committee after advising both captains of their intention to do so.
 - Where no pool umpire officiates, the aggrieved captain may refer the matter to his club secretary who will first refer the matter to his opposite number in the other club. After referral, if no satisfactory conclusion is reached, the Club Secretary shall send a full report to the Secretary of the I'Anson Management Committee, who will refer the matter to the chairman of the Disciplinary Sub-Committee for action.

DISCIPLINARY PROCESS

We introduced a new system for administering discipline in 2012, devised after consultation with both Umpires and Captains. In general, the procedures worked well, thanks in no small part to the umpires and captains who worked well together to achieve the main intention, namely that cricket in the l'Anson Competitions is played fairly and in accordance with all accepted disciplinary standards.

Consequently, the Management Committee agreed to continue these for 2013. There is no change to the level of sanctions, except that clubs may increase the sanction to be applied for their own purposes.

The procedure is as described on the next page, and a copy of the Report Form is also shown.

Umpires are requested to note the following:

- Please be concise in the description of the incident
- Automatic sanctions for abuse only relate to verbal abuse. Any case of physical abuse can only be referred to the DSC. The extent of any sanction will not be pre-determined, but will be considered solely on the facts of the case
- If an umpire considers that a reportable, but comparatively minor, offence has occurred, the umpire must complete a report but ask that the Club itself deals with the miscreant
- If only one umpire is standing, he should still complete a report form if he considers that a reportable incident has occurred
- To meet the stated desire of umpires for matters to be dealt with quickly and with certainty, there is a tight timetable – co-operation is sought from umpires in particular to meet this

If a team receives three separate reports during the season, the captain will be referred to a hearing of the DSC on the third report. Further sanctions against the captain and/or team will be considered, including the deduction of points. These procedures will apply in any match in the l'Anson Competitions, irrespective of Division or Cup, where an umpire has been appointed by the Umpires' Secretary to officiate. Clubs who organise their own tournaments using l'Anson umpires should arrange their own disciplinary process.

All players are reminded of the Spirit of Cricket published by the ECB, as follows:

Captains are reminded they are responsible for team discipline ensuring, at all times, there is

- No breach of the spirit of the game
- No failure to comply with an Umpire's instructions
- No criticising of an umpire's decision
- No showing dissent
- No bringing the game into disrepute

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I'ANSON FACILITIES REQUIREMENTS

Introduction

1. This note sets out the minimum ground and club standards and facilities which the I'Anson Management Committee would encourage member clubs to provide on a regular basis for matches within the Competitions. The standards are also those which the Committee expects candidate clubs to be able to meet on application to join the Competitions.

Playing area

2. The playing area standards set out below are (with the exception of boundary distance) those which clubs should be able to meet, provided they are prepared to make the necessary effort. Clubs which consistently fail to meet these standards will be appropriately warned and will be offered advice on how to improve. Continuing failure could result in sanctions being applied by the Management Committee, the nature of the sanction being related to the level of cricket (i.e. the division or divisions) concerned.
3. The standards are:
 - Pitch to be properly cut, rolled and marked out according to Laws of Cricket (see diagram below).
 - To prepare a Strip of an acceptable level suitable for recreational cricket and lower levels of league cricket. Any consistent complaints about the standard of pitches, by either an opposing Captain or Umpires, will be dealt with by the IMC by independently assessing and reporting on the standard of the pitch and recommended remedial action.
 - To prepare the Outfield, cut to a reasonable level, without large accumulated clumps of cut grass
 - Boundary continuously marked with white line, rope or other clearly identifiable feature.
 - Minimum boundary of 40m from the nearest stumps (but see note 2 below). It is recommended that the boundary line should be a least two metres from any identifiable hazard, eg a steep slope or rigid fence. Where for any reason this is not practicable, appropriate warning should be given to visiting teams.

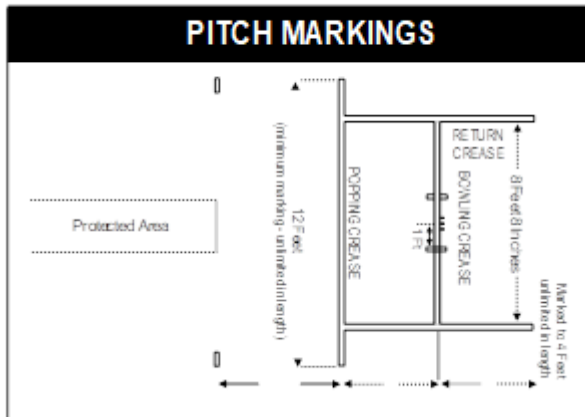
Clubhouse

4. The Committee recognises that the nature and standard of club facilities varies greatly between clubs, depending on the resources available to the clubs concerned and to the facilities providers (where these are not the clubs). But the Committee feels that clubs should aspire to certain minimum levels of provision, as set out below:
 - Changing Rooms for 2 x 11 players. Separate area for umpires.
 - Separate changing room area for umpires
 - Showers
 - Designated toilets for males and females
 - Tea area (under cover) for both teams
 - Area for players, umpires and spectators to shelter during wet weather
 - Designated area for scorers with tables and chairs, and ideally an external socket in close vicinity
 - Scoreboard and scorebook
 - Drinks facilities for both innings
5. There may be circumstances where clubs are for physical or logistical reasons unable to provide these basic facilities. But where the failure is due more to lack of effort and is a continuing one, the Management Committee will take the matter up with the club concerned to establish the reasons for the failure and to discuss appropriate solutions. Consistent report of poor pitch/facilities may result in a fine and/or points deductions.

Note 1: For a few clubs, it may be physically impossible to provide a 40m boundary for all or indeed any matches. In these circumstances, the clubs concerned are expected to provide the

maximum boundary distance which conditions allow, and to organise matches in such a way as to ensure that their teams playing in the higher divisions benefit from the maximum boundary distances at the expense of their teams playing in the lower divisions.

I'Anson Cup Competition Rules of Play

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Stevens Cup & Pope Cup Competitions Rules of Play

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- A Title**
1. The name shall be 'Anson Cup Competitions, hereinafter called 'The Competitions'
- B Objective**
1. The Competitions exist to foster & encourage amateur cricket.
- C Competitions format**
1. The Competitions are split into two formats:
 - a. 'Anson Cup, which is played in a divisional format on Saturday afternoons and the rules of the Competitions cover all divisions except where stated
 - b. The Stevens & Pope Cup games will be played according to the rules in Section 3 of the Rules of Play. The finals are played on a Sunday as determined by the Management Committee.
 2. In this document, the term 'Anson Cup Competition' represents all divisions, and the term 'Evening Competition' represents both Stevens Cup and Pope Cup.
- D Management**
1. The Competitions will be controlled and managed by a Management Committee, which shall comprise the officers of The Competitions and up to nine other members.
 2. The officers of The Competitions are: The President, Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Umpires' Secretary, Fixtures Secretary and Disciplinary Secretary.
 3. With the exception of the President, all officers and other members of the Management Committee will be elected annually at the Annual Delegates' Meeting, and all will be eligible for re-election at the following ADM without re-nomination.
 - 3a. The president will be elected at an ADM and will stand for a maximum of three years and can stand for re-election for a further three years.
 4. Any nomination for an office or a position on the Management Committee must be lodged with the secretary by September 1 for inclusion in voting in that year's ADM.
 5. With the exception of officers, who may be either independent or affiliated to a member club, other Management Committee positions may only be filled by members of member clubs, with a maximum of one general Management Committee member from any member club.
 6. The Chairman shall preside at Management Committee Meetings and ADMs and SDMs. In the absence of the Chairman, the Management Committee members present shall elect one of their number to chair the meeting, this person having the full chairmanship powers of the Chairman.
 7. A quorum of the Management Committee shall comprise six members, three of whom must be officers of The Competitions.
 8. Should it be necessary to vote on a motion at a Management Committee meeting, each member present will be entitled to one vote. In the case of an equal number of votes cast, the chairman of the meeting shall have a second, casting vote.
 9. Management Committee meetings will not be open to the public or the press. The chairman, through the secretary, shall provide any reports, rulings or instructions to the clubs and the press. Any disciplinary decisions will not be provided to the press.
 10. Minutes of all Management Committee meetings will be produced by the secretary.
 11. The Management Committee shall have the power to co-opt persons as it sees fit, although co-opted members may not vote.
 12. The duties of the Management Committee shall include the following:
 - a. To manage The Competitions
 - b. To organise fixtures, and the structure of The Competitions
 - c. To manage The Competitions' finances
 - d. To communicate important issues relating to The Competitions to all member clubs.
 - e. To hear and dispose of any complaints or suggestions, properly made in writing to the secretary, by the secretary of a member club, or another office

- f. To ensure that member clubs and players comply with the rules of The Competitions, and to exercise disciplinary measures where necessary.
 - g. To co-ordinate available pool umpires.
 - h. To monitor and inspect the grounds and facilities of member and prospective member clubs.
 - i. To appoint a rules sub-committee, a disciplinary sub-committee, a dinner sub-committee, and a sub-committee to oversee the Stevens Cup and Pope Cup matches, and any other sub-committee(s) deemed necessary to deal with any particular business or to furnish any special report.
 - j. To organise ADMs, SDMs, and Captains meeting
 - k. To select representative teams and officials
 - l. To determine the winner of the Player of the Year awards
13. Any matters not expressly covered within The Constitution, Rules of Play or the Laws of Cricket shall be within the power of the Management Committee to determine as it sees fit.
14. The decision of the Management Committee shall in all cases be final.

E Membership

1. Only clubs within a radius of approximately 12 miles of Grayshott Village Hall are eligible to apply to compete.
2. All new clubs wishing to enter The Competitions and all existing clubs wishing to renew their membership of The Competitions for the following season must submit the application form (which will be provided by the secretary), accompanied by the annual subscription fee set by the Management Committee, to reach the secretary by September 1 annually. The completed membership application form must also confirm that the club has or will have adequate public liability insurance cover of at least £2 million for the duration of the entire playing season to which the membership application relates. Member clubs will also be required to indicate their intentions concerning their participation in the evening competition for the following season on this membership application form.
3. New clubs applying to compete must demonstrate to a member of the Management Committee, at an inspection, that at least the minimum standards for grounds and facilities determined by the Management Committee exist.
4. New clubs eligible under E1, E2 and E3 may be elected to membership only at either an ADM or SDM, when a vote will be taken from the existing member clubs.
5. If payment of any club's annual subscription fee is not received by September 1 for the following playing season, a surcharge to the subscription fee will be levied, this being increased by a further surcharge for each month until payment is received (refer to Section J).

F General meetings

1. An ADM or SDM are the only meetings authorised to amend the constitution or rules of The Competitions and elect new clubs to membership.
2. Every club with membership of The Competitions, including new clubs, which have been elected to membership earlier in the same meeting, shall be eligible to nominate one delegate to be the official representative of their club, and who alone may vote on any motions put to a general meeting.
3. Subject to F2, there is no restriction on the number of club members or members of the public who may attend general meetings.
4. In the case of an equal number of votes cast at a general meeting, the chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote.

Annual Delegates' Meeting

5. Any matters of common interest to the member clubs may be discussed at a general meeting although no amendments may be passed that have not been properly proposed and notified to the clubs.

6. The Annual Delegates' Meeting, referred to within this document as ADM, will be arranged by the Management Committee and be held by 30th November annually. Notification of the date, time and venue will be published to member clubs by September 1 annually.

Special Delegates' Meeting

7. The Management Committee shall have the power to call a Special Delegates' Meeting, referred to within this document as SDM, the secretary to give member clubs a minimum of 14 days' notice.
8. A SDM may also be convened on application to the secretary by six or more competing clubs, stating the objects of such a meeting. Provided that the objects of the meeting are not within the power of the Management Committee to resolve, such a meeting will be convened at the earliest opportunity, while providing member clubs with a minimum of 14 days' notice.

G Amendments to the Constitution and Rules

1. The rules sub-committee shall meet on as many occasions as it deems necessary, to review the rules of The Competitions and to consider ideas or proposals submitted by member clubs or by the Management Committee.
2. Proposals for rule changes from member clubs must be submitted to the secretary by August 1 annually for inclusion in that year's ADM.
3. A proposal received from a club in accordance with G2 will be forwarded by the secretary to the rules sub-committee, which will draft the full content of the proposal into a formal resolution on which a vote can be taken
4. The secretary will then forward any such resolutions, as outlined in G3 above, to all member clubs by September 15 annually.
5. Having received the proposed resolutions as outlined in G4, member clubs that wish to submit amendments to the proposals may do so, provided the secretary receives these by October 7, with any alternatives being worded precisely into resolution format on which a vote can be taken.
6. The finalised resolutions will be forwarded to clubs by the secretary, together with the agenda for the ADM, by October 14 annually.
7. The only proposals to alter the constitution or rules of play that will be permitted to be raised at general meetings shall be those submitted in accordance with the aforementioned procedure (G2-G6). No additions or amendments to the published resolutions whatsoever will be permitted at any general meeting.
8. Changes to the constitution or rules of play may only be implemented if they achieve a majority vote at an ADM or SDM.

H Finance

1. The financial year of The Competitions shall commence on October 1 and end on September 30.
2. The Competitions shall be financed by subscription from member clubs, donations and any other means determined by the Management Committee.
3. All monies shall be banked in the name of The Competitions.
4. The Management Committee shall keep an account of all income and expenditure of The Competitions and at each ADM shall present to the membership a report and statement of accounts for the preceding financial year, certified by signature of an independent auditor.
5. Subscriptions to compete in The Competitions will be set annually by the Management Committee and shall be published to all member clubs by August 1 for the following season.

J Fines and penalties

1. Subject to the Management Committee being satisfied as to the responsibility, the following scale of fines and/or penalties shall apply:

- Failure to pay annual subscription fee by the due date: Mandatory £20 surcharge on due date, plus further £20 each month until payment is received (One:E5)
 - A proven disciplinary offence found at disciplinary hearing: Any combination of a reprimand and/or maximum fine of £50 and/or suspension may be levied. The Management Committee to have powers to deduct points. The number of points to be determined by the Management Committee (One:K5). A proven disciplinary offence in a Stevens/Pope cup match could conclude in a change of the result.
 - Gross misconduct found by emergency Management Committee meeting: Expulsion of player may be applied. The Management Committee to have powers to deduct points. The number of points to be determined by the Management Committee. (One:K7)
 - Failure to fulfil I'Anson Cup fixture or cancelling I'Anson Cup fixture, any umpires fees, plus any reasonable and unavoidable costs incurred by opposition, plus deduction of points. (Two:2h).
 - Failure to commence I'Anson Cup match on time: Maximum £20 fine may be levied. (Two:3a)
 - Fielding ineligible player in I'Anson Cup match: Mandatory fine of £20 per ineligible player fielded plus forfeit of points as determined by the Management Committee (Two:4b, d, e & f)
 - Failure to give priority to senior teams: Maximum £25 fine and/or loss of points. (Two:4c)
 - Failure of the home team to provide the prescribed new balls: a fine of £25
 - Failure of home team to notify I'Anson Cup match result in time: Mandatory £20 fine per fixture. (Two:6d)
 - Failure to fulfil a Stevens Cup or Pope Cup fixture, a mandatory forfeit of the match plus any unavoidable umpires' fees.
 - Fielding ineligible player in Stevens Cup or Pope Cup: Reversal of result may apply, plus mandatory fine of £10 per ineligible player fielded. (Three:SP4d)
 - Failure to notify Stevens Cup or Pope Cup match result in time: Mandatory £10 fine. (Three:SP7b)
 - Failure to return trophies by 31st July: fine £20 (Two:7i and Three:SP8c)
 - Failure to engrave trophies in matching script: fine £20 plus cost of engraving (Two:7j and Three:SP8d)
 - Failure to provide club details for inclusion in the Year Book by 15th February: mandatory fine of £20.
- 2 The Management Committee shall deal with non-payment of fines by the due date, and may impose such penalties for late payments, as it deems appropriate.

K Discipline

1. It shall be a disciplinary offence for any player, official, other club member or member club in connection with The Competitions to misconduct themselves, or to act at any time in a manner which prejudices the good name or interests of The Competitions, or to breach the rules of The Competitions.
The Management Committee shall have unfettered authority to refer any matter which comes to its attention, either directly or from any third party, to the disciplinary process.
2. All disciplinary matters in any way connected with the League or the conduct of matches or tournaments played under the auspices of the League shall be dealt with in accordance with the ECB Discipline Regulations Guidelines which shall be deemed to be incorporated within and form part of these Rules and which shall prevail over any of the League's rules which may overlap or be in conflict with the provisions in the ECB Guidelines
3. As noted in the ECB Discipline Regulations Guidelines every notice of appeal shall be accompanied by a deposit cheque for £50 payable to I'Anson Competitions.

4. For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in this section K shall prevent the proper application of Safeguarding regulations as laid out by the ECB, and which shall take precedence.

SECTION TWO – I'ANSON CUP COMPETITIONS RULES OF PLAY

1 GENERAL

- a. All matches shall be played according to the current MCC Laws of Cricket, but as further amended by these rules. The Competitions shall apply the ECB's Safe Hands policy, including ECB directives on playing conditions for junior cricketers.
- b1. The imposition of penalty runs shall only apply where a pool umpire is officiating. The exceptions are Law 28.2 (illegally fielding the ball), and Law 28.3, (ball striking a protective helmet on the ground belonging to the fielding side), which shall apply throughout.
- b2. In MCC law 41.7 concerning the delivery of high-pitched full tosses (beamers), only pool umpires will apply it as laid out in the 2019 law book.
- b3. The revised MCC law 5.7 regarding the weight of bats will not apply.
- c. It will be the responsibility of the home club to provide a new match ball for the start of each innings. All match balls will be supplied through the Competition.
- d. Whenever possible, both umpires officiating in matches will be appointed from a pool of independent umpires and subject to availability.
- e. In any matches in which umpire(s) cannot be provided from the pool, it shall be the responsibility of each side to provide a fair and competent umpire(s). Where players are asked to officiate, it shall be the responsibility of the captain concerned to ensure that the player-umpire is conversant with the current Laws of Cricket and is over eighteen years of age.

2 POINTS

- a. In all matches, points shall be awarded as follows:

Win	20 points
Draw (faster/identical scoring rate)	12 points
Draw {slower scoring rate)	4 points
Tie	12 points
Loss	0 points
- b. Bonus points shall be awarded in each match as follows, except in the case of tied games where no bonus points shall be awarded:
For the Losing/ Losing Draw Side Batting Second:

Scoring 60% of the winning side's score	1 point
Scoring 70% of the winning side's score	2 points
Scoring 80% of the winning side's score	3 points
Scoring 90% of the winning side's score	4 points

For the Losing/ Losing Draw Side Bowling Second:

Taking 3 wickets of winning side	1 point
Taking 5 wickets of winning side	2 points
Taking 7 wickets of winning side	3 points
Taking 9 wickets of winning side	4 points

Bonus points not gained by the losing/ losing draw side will be awarded to the winning/ winning draw side.
- c. A result can only be achieved if both teams have the opportunity of batting for at least 20 overs. However, should an innings be completed, or a target reached within 20 overs the match shall be completed. The only result that isn't permissible if the team batting second doesn't receive 20 overs is the draw.
In the case where a team fails to fulfil or cancels a fixture for unacceptable reasons the following points will be awarded:

Team cancelled against	24 points
Offending team	Minus 20 points

Cancelled matches shall be considered for the calculation referred to in Section Two: 7a.

Abandoned matches will not be considered for the calculation referred to in Section Two: 7a.

- d. Scoring rates shall be calculated by dividing runs by legal deliveries bowled. In the event that a team is dismissed without using their allocation the full allocation will be used to determine the scoring rate, Should a side declare within their allotted overs they will be deemed to have used their full allocation.
- e. The results of all matches (including cancellations) must be notified by the home club to The Competitions by noon on the Monday following the fixture with a full scorecard on the 'Play Cricket' Website including bonus points for both Teams. Failure to do so will result in a penalty per default per team being levied (refer to Section J).

It is the responsibility of both Teams to check the result, and award of bonus points that has been entered on the 'Play Cricket' Website. Any errors and corrections need to be notified to the Secretary within two weeks of the fixture being played. After this time no amendments will be made to the points awarded. Results and the award of points for matches in the penultimate week of the season need to be confirmed by the start of the final round of matches. Once the final round of matches starts the league tables will be deemed to be correct.

3 MATCH RULES

- a. The league will be based on matches as advised to clubs between the first Saturday in May and 18 consecutive Saturdays thereafter, unless otherwise notified
- b. All matches must be played on the Club's home ground unless notification is received, at least 24 hours before the match is due to be played, in writing to the Competition Secretary. Both clubs must agree to the change before notification is submitted to the secretary.
- c. A decision concerning whether a ground is unfit for play shall only be made for reason of player safety. **Before cancelling, those involved must be certain that the ground will remain unfit for play and the game would not be able to get underway until after the latest start times outlined in rule 3h.**
- d.
 - i. **The decision to cancel a match prior to the toss taking place must be agreed by both captains. If the captains cannot reach agreement, pool umpires shall make the decision. However, for matches where no pool umpire is present and where agreement between captains cannot be reached, either captain may contact a member of the Management Committee or an official umpire at a local match, to request an independent pitch inspection be made on the same day. In the event that one team feels it has grounds for a complaint, it may report the matter to the Management Committee**
 - ii. **In the event that a game has already started the following rules apply in terms of determining the fitness of the ground to re-commence play:**
 - 1. **Where pool umpires are present it is the umpires' decision on the fitness of conditions which is final. Captains and players should not be involved**
 - 2. **Where there are no pool umpires it is the responsibility of the two captains to come to an agreement to determine the fitness of conditions. If no agreement can be reached, the responsibility will lie with the home captain. A decision to abandon a match should only be taken on the grounds of player safety and not be influenced by the state of the match. Any complaints in this regard should be addressed to the Management Committee.**
- e. Weather permitting, play will commence at 1.00pm unless an earlier or later alternative start time is agreed between the clubs concerned and notified to the Competitions Secretary.
- f. All matches shall be one innings per side.
- g. In a match unaffected by inclement weather, the time of the tea interval shall be either two and a half hours after the scheduled start time of the match, or after the close of the innings of the side batting first, whichever occurs later. In other circumstances, the captains shall

agree the time of the tea interval. The tea interval shall be of a maximum of 30 minutes' duration.

- h. For late starts due to any reason, overs shall be deducted on the basis of two overs (one over for each innings) for every complete seven minutes lost.

The latest time matches can start (20 overs per side) is as follows:

Divisions 1-3: Must start by 4.15pm

Divisions 4-7: Must start by 3.50pm

In the draw (traditional) format where time has been lost in the match after the game has started, the second innings must start by 6.00pm. If this is not possible or if there are further delays after 6.00pm the game is abandoned as per rule 3Bdiii.

A. LIMITED OVERS FORMAT

- a. Divisions 1, 2 and 3: A match shall comprise 90 overs. The innings of each side batting shall last no longer than 45 overs.

The bowling side should achieve a minimum bowling rate of 16 overs per hour. The time limit to bowl the required overs is 3 hours. Failure to meet this limit will result in a 5-run penalty to be added to the score of the batting side for every over the bowling side is short at the cut-off time.

- b. Divisions 4, 5, 6 and 7: A match shall comprise 80 overs. The innings of each side batting shall last no longer than 40 overs.

The bowling side should achieve a minimum bowling rate of 16 overs an hour. The time limit to bowl the required overs is 2 hours and 45 minutes. Failure to meet this limit will result in a 5-run penalty to be added to the score of the batting side for every over the bowling side is short at the cut-off time.

- c. FOR DIVISION 1 only

- i. LEGSIDE WIDES: Any ball passing outside the line of leg stump and legside of the batsman shall be called wide
- ii. FIELDING CIRCLE: There must be 4 fielders (excluding the bowler and wicketkeeper) inside a circle at the instant of delivery by the bowler. The circle should comprise of two semi-circles that have at their centre, the middle stump at either end of the pitch. The radius of the semi-circles shall be 30 yards.
- iii. FREE HIT: In the event of a foot fault no ball, the next delivery will be a "free hit". The field placings for the "free hit" will not change from the previous delivery. Allowance will be made for a change from left to right-handed batsmen and vice-versa.

- d. INTERRUPTIONS:

- i. In the event of an interruption to play occurring after the start of the match the number of overs available in the game is reduced at the rate of one over for every completed period of 3.5 minutes. Overs will be reduced from both innings at an equal rate.

Note: This may mean that on the resumption of play the first innings is effectively closed

- ii. The winning target will be revised on the basis of Duckworth Lewis (DLS) calculations. The Duckworth-Lewis-Stern option within the D/L calculator found in the Tools section of the Play-Cricket Scorer app is the mandated method for calculating the revised target. The calculation and agreement of the revised target is the responsibility of the captains before play commences/ recommences.

Note: The D/L calculator can be applied for multiple stoppages during an innings. It is important to note the number of overs bowled and the score at each stoppage for the D/L calculator to operate properly.

- iii. A minimum of 20 overs need to be available in the second innings to constitute a game, else the game is abandoned
- iv. Bonus points targets will be revised on the basis of the revised winning target

B DRAW CRICKET (TRADITIONAL) FORMAT

- a. Divisions 1, 2 and 3: A match shall comprise a maximum of 90 overs. The innings of the side batting first shall last no longer than 48 overs. Any over not completed
- b. Divisions 4, 5, 6 and 7: A match shall comprise a maximum of 80 overs. The innings of the side batting first shall last no longer than 43 overs.
- c. Any over not completed due to a declaration of end of innings shall be regarded as a full over, except when calculating run rate.
- d. INTERRUPTIONS:
 - i. Any interruption to play occurring after the start of the match shall result in a reduction in the number of overs available for play in the whole match at the rate of one over for each completed period of 3.5 minutes.
 - ii. The batting side may still bat for their full allocation.
 - iii. The side batting second can bat for the number of overs that remain in the game. However, a minimum of 20 overs need to be available to constitute a game, else the game is abandoned.
 - iv. The winning target is not revised
 - v. Bonus point targets are not revised

C. BOWLING LIMITS:

- i. In Divisions 1, 2, and 3: In limited overs matches no bowler will be permitted to bowl more than 9 overs in an innings. In traditional format matches no bowler will be permitted to bowl more than 14 overs in an innings.
- ii. In Divisions 4, 5, 6, and 7: No bowler will be permitted to bowl more than 9 overs in an innings.
- iii. LIMITED OVERS FORMAT ONLY: In the event that time is lost in the game the number of overs a bowler can bowl is limited to one fifth of the innings total, unless more have been bowled prior to the interruption.

D ELIGIBILITY RULES

- a. A team shall normally comprise 11 players. However, a team must play when comprising eight players or more. Priority must be given to senior teams in terms of fielding a full team of 11 players, and where matches are conceded.
- b. The following players are NOT eligible to play for a club in any match in The Competitions:
 - b1. Those who have already played for another club in The Competitions in the current season. However, any such player wishing to transfer may apply, only before August 1st, by submitting the written agreement of the player's former club with the application to the secretary, who shall have the power to agree the transfer. Where the former club fails to agree the transfer, the Management Committee may nevertheless authorise the transfer if it considers agreement to have been unreasonably withheld.
AND
 - b2. A player who has in the current season already played for a club 1st XI in the Surrey Championship, Premier Division, 1st Division, or 2nd Division; or the Hampshire Southern Electric Premier cricket league; **or the Thames Valley Cricket League Divisions 1, 2a, 2b, 3a and 3b.**
AND
 - b3. Within the last 4 scheduled fixtures of the season, if the player has in the current season already played for another **team** in another adult Saturday competitive league anywhere in the UK. This restriction shall not apply where the player has played for the club in the Competitions in at least half of the completed fixtures in that season.
- c. In addition to Two:3Db3, within the last four scheduled fixtures of the season no more than TWO players who have played seven or more times in a higher team for their club, in either The Competitions or any other Saturday competitive league competitions, may be permitted to play in any lower team within their club in The Competitions, unless the prior written consent of the Management Committee has been obtained.
Within the last two scheduled fixtures of the season for clubs with more than one team in The Competitions players will only be eligible to play for lower teams if the majority of their

appearances in that season have been for the lower team, unless the prior written consent of the Management Committee has been obtained. This rule does not apply to clubs with 3rd and 4th teams within The Competitions where their players have the majority of appearances in the 3rd and 4th teams. There are no restrictions to playing up in higher teams for their club.

This rule applies only to players who have played 5 or more fixtures in the current season prior to game week 17.

- d. No player may play for more than one team for the same club on the same day (other than as a substitute)
- e. No player shall receive any payment for playing in the competitions, either in the form of remuneration or payment of expenses connected with participation in a match (such payment shall not, however, be deemed to include the sharing between players of reasonable transport expenses or the receipt of end of season prizes, other than cash, for exceptional performance). The receipt of a prohibited payment shall render the player ineligible to play again during the season.

4 PROMOTION AND RELEGATION

- a. Positions in all divisions will be based on an average points per match basis. In the event of two or more teams finishing with identical average points, the team with the most bonus points will have the advantage. If still level, overall results of all divisional matches played in that season between the relevant teams will determine the team awarded the advantage. If still level, the team with the most wins will have the advantage.
- b. The Management Committee will determine the winner of player of the year trophies for each division.
- c. Promotion and relegation in each division will be on a two-up and two-down basis or as advised by the management Committee prior to the commencement of the season.
- d. No club may have two teams in the same division, apart from the lowest division. If a club has a team in a division to which another of its teams is relegated, the other team will also be relegated. Conversely, a team cannot be promoted into a higher division if the club has a team in the higher division.
- e. In the event of new teams joining or existing teams leaving The Competitions, the Management Committee shall have the power to modify the promotion and/or relegation arrangements to enable changes in the structure of the divisions.
- f. It is the responsibility of winning clubs to engrave the Trophies. The trophies must be returned to the Secretary by July 31st for re-presentation.

5 INVESTIGATIVE POWER

- a. The Management Committee will have the right to investigate any game where the conduct of any teams as a whole, or players within those teams is considered contrary to the Spirit of Cricket, or the integrity of the l'Anson League. The Management Committee will have the power to apply any sanctions deemed appropriate.

SECTION THREE – STEVENS CUP & POPE CUP RULES OF PLAY

SP1 GENERAL

- a. All matches shall be played according to the MCC Laws of cricket with penalty runs as outlined in section 2 – 1b.
- b. Clubs may only enter one team in the Stevens Cup/ Plate Competition. Teams in Divisions 1 and 2 of the I'Anson Cup Competition will compete for the Stevens Cup, and Plate Competition.
- c. Clubs may only enter one team in the Pope Cup. Teams in Divisions 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of the I'Anson Cup competition will compete for the Pope Cup. Clubs entering the Stevens Cup may add a second team into the Pope Cup subject to the above.
- d. All Clubs losing their first match in the Stevens Cup shall be eligible to play in the Plate. [This also applies to matches where a team is entering the competition following a bye and is playing their first match. The loser of this match will also qualify for the Plate.]
- e. One new ball of identical specification to that used for the I'Anson Cup Competition shall be provided either by The Competitions, or failing that by the home club, and shall be used for all matches apart from the finals.

SP2 SEASON, FIXTURES, GROUNDS

- a. All matches shall be played on a knockout basis.
- b. All matches, apart from the finals, will be played on Tuesdays on the weeks determined by the Management Committee.
The finals will be played on a date, time and venue determined by the Management Committee.
- c. **In the event of an interruption to play occurring before or after the start of the match the number of overs available in the game is reduced at the rate of one over for every completed period of 3.5 minutes. Overs will be reduced from both innings at an equal rate. Note: This may mean that on the resumption of play the first innings is effectively closed. In matches where the delay has occurred before the start of the game then the minimum length of the match will be an 8-over a side game. In matches where the delay has occurred after the start of the game then the number of overs available in the second innings must be a minimum of 8. If less than 8 overs are available in the second innings then the match will be considered abandoned and will be rescheduled as per rule SP3e.**
- d. **The winning target will be revised on the basis of Duckworth Lewis (DLS) calculations. The Duckworth-Lewis-Stern option within the D/L calculator found in the Tools section of the Play-Cricket Scorer app is the mandated method for calculating the revised target. The calculation and agreement of the revised target is the responsibility of the captains before play commences/ recommences. Note: The D/L calculator can be applied for multiple stoppages during an innings. It is important to note the number of overs bowled and the score at each stoppage for the D/L calculator to operate properly**
- e. **If matches cannot be played on the day and time due to an unfit ground, then every effort should be made to play the tie during the same week. Alternatively, it must be re-arranged no later than the week before the next round. If no agreement can be reached by the two clubs then it shall be decided by the Management Committee. In the event that the tie cannot be played before the week of the next round the result will be determined by the toss of a coin, unless otherwise agreed by the Knockout Sub-Committee.**
- f. **If for any reason the finals are abandoned after play has commenced, the matches shall be replayed as determined by the Management Committee.**

- SP3 TIMINGS
- a. Each innings shall be of a maximum of 16 six-ball overs in the group matches except the finals. In the finals each innings shall be a maximum of 20 six-ball overs. In overs 1 to 15 (or 1-19 in the finals), any wide or no-ball, will result in a two-run penalty, but no extra balls will be bowled in the over. In the final over of each innings, there will still be two penalty runs added to the score for wides and no-balls, but there will be extra deliveries.
 - b. Matches where the start is delayed shall result in the maximum number of overs being reduced by one for each innings for each seven complete minutes lost, to a minimum of 12 overs per innings.
 - c. If for any reason the finals are abandoned after play has commenced, the matches shall be replayed as determined by the Management Committee.
- SP4 PLAYERS, TEAM PRECEDENCE AND NUMBERS
- a. A player must be eligible to play for his club under Rule 3D of the I'Anson Cup Competition AND be a club member (see also Rule SP4b).
 - b. To be eligible a player must have PLAYED at least four times for his club in the I'Anson Competition in the previous season or at least once for his club in the current season. **A player will be ineligible if they have played for another team in another adult Saturday competitive league anywhere in the UK in the current season.**
To be eligible to play in the semi-final round of the evening competition, a player must have PLAYED at least twice for his club in the I'Anson Cup Competition in the current season, and in the final of the evening competition, he must have PLAYED at least three times for his club in the I'Anson Cup Competition in the current season (see also Rule SP4c). Those bona-fide members of a club aged 17 and under will also be eligible to play subject to ECB regulations.
 - c. In all cases brought to its notice in time and proved to its satisfaction, the Management Committee shall have the power to levy a penalty for any breach of Rules SP4a, SP4b (refer to Section 1- J).
 - d. When a club has entered more than one team into the competitions players will only be eligible to play in the Stevens/Plate competition or Pope Cup competition. Any deviations to this need to have prior authorisation from the Management Committee.
- SP5 BOWLING AND FIELDING
- a. No bowler shall bowl more than four overs out of the allotted number.
 - b. Any ball passing outside the line of the leg stump and legside of the batsman shall be called wide by the bowler's end umpire.
 - c. There will be fielding restrictions. There must be 4 fielders inside the circle at the instant of delivery. The circle should comprise of 2 semi circles that have at their centre the middle stump at either end of the pitch. The radius of the semi circles shall be 30 yards.
 - d. In the event of a foot fault no ball, the next delivery will be a "free hit". The field placings for the "free hit" will not be changed from the previous delivery. Allowance will be made for a change from left to right-handed batsmen and vice-versa.
- SP6 WINNING TEAMS, POINTS AND MATCH RESULTS
- a. In the event of ties the "super over" will come into play.
 - b. For the "super over", the two captains will toss up and the winner will decide whether to bat or bowl. Any one bowler will bowl the whole over of six balls, irrespective of whether he had bowled the full allowance of four overs in the match. Any members of the batting side can bat, irrespective of whether they had been dismissed during the match. Bowling and fielding restrictions in SP6b, SP6c and SP6d will apply. The team that scores the most runs will be the winners.
 - c. Results of all matches (including cancellations and postponements) must be notified by the home club to The Competitions within 24 hours of the match ending. Failure to do so will result in a penalty being levied (refer to Section 1 - J).

SP7

CHAMPION TEAMS, TROPHIES

- a. The champion teams in the evening competition shall be awarded the Stevens Cup, the Plate and the Pope Cup respectively.
- b. Medals or other suitable emblems shall be provided from The Competitions' funds and be presented to members of each winning and runner-up team.
- c. The trophies are challenge trophies and cannot be won outright. The secretary will insure them, but clubs holding these shall be responsible for taking reasonable precautions for their safe custody. The trophies must be returned to the Secretary by May 31st for re-presentation. Failure to comply to incur a fine of £10.
- d. It is the responsibility of the winning clubs to engrave the Trophies, in matching script, before returning them to the Secretary. Failure to comply to incur a fine of £10 plus the cost of engraving.
