

# Blackheath Cricket Club

## Rules for use of nets – July 2021

- Outside club training session times, the nets are available for use by club members, subject to compliance with the rules below. Use by club members outside club training sessions is at their own risk and club members are expected to satisfy themselves that the nets are safe to use, especially if it has rained recently and they are still damp.
- It is not necessary to pre-book the nets, however they can be pre-booked by paid up members via the booking system at <https://blackheath.skedda.com/booking> or for a pre-arranged 1:1 coaching session with Ronny or Danny Harrison contact [ronny@matchfitacademy.com](mailto:ronny@matchfitacademy.com); 07341 813723; [danny@matchfitacademy.com](mailto:danny@matchfitacademy.com); 07760 665222) for further details. Pre-booked sessions have priority over those who have not booked.
- Do not come to the nets if you, or a member of your household, has symptoms of coronavirus however mild. Please wash your hands thoroughly before and after visiting the club and sanitise your hands before and after every session. Inform the club immediately if you or any member of your household develops symptoms of coronavirus within 7 days of having used the nets.
- If an U18 is doing a 1:1 coaching session, or if children under 16 are using the nets, **a parent must remain** in eyesight and earshot at all times.
- Bring all your own equipment. The bowling machine may only be used outside club training sessions under the supervision of an authorised adult member and is used at members' own risk. It must be put back in its box in the plant room after use.
- Toilets are not generally available when the pavilion is open for club training sessions, matches or other events.

**Remember to follow all government health guidelines and sanitise your hands before and after.**
